

Morden is a London Underground station in the London Borough of Merton. The station is the southern terminus for the Northern line and is the most southerly station on the Underground network. The station is situated in Travelcard Zone 4 and benefits from an annual footfall of 8.26 million passengers.

Morden is home to the National Trusts Morden Hall Park, Library, a new community leisure centre and St Helier Hospital under two miles away. Operators within the immediate vicinity include Dominoes, Lidl, Iceland, Costa Coffee, KFC, Subway, Superdrug, Boots and CEX.
